Avicenna or as called by Persians, Ibn Sina, was born in 980. The great Persian physician, philosopher, and scientist was the author of 450 books on many subjects, many on philosophy and medicine. He is considered "The Father of Modern Medicine" and is one of the greatest physicians of all ages. His most famous works are *The Book of Healing* and *The Canon of Medicine*, also known as the Qanun. All his works were written in Arabic (the scientific language of that era) and in Persian.

As a child he displayed an exceptional intellectual behaviour. He turned to medicine at the age of 17 and described it in his own words as "not difficult". Later in his life he moved to Ray, where he followed his job in medicine more than ever before. When Ray was surrounded by the enemy, Ibn Sina ran away to Hamadan where he cured Amir Shamsud-Dawala and was made Prime Minister. Following the death of the Amir, Ibn Sina escaped to Isfahan after having troubles with the law. He died only 57 years old.

In the museum at Bukhara, you can find many of his writings. An impressive monument to the life and works of the man who is known as the 'Doctor of Doctors' still stands outside Bukhara museum and his portrait hangs in the Hall of the Faculty of Medicine in the University of Paris.

Shakespeare is one of the best playwrights of all time. He wrote an estimated 37 plays, including *Romeo and Juliet*, *Hamlet*, and *Macbeth*. Despite having been written hundreds of years ago, Shakespeare's work remains popular because of his interesting characters, complex stories, and artful dialogue.

Nothing is known for certain about what Shakespeare did between 1585 and 1592. Whatever the case, Shakespeare had become known as a dramatist and an actor in London by 1592. Some of his early works include *Titus Andronicus* and *The Two Gentleman of Verona*. A deadly outbreak of a disease known as 'the plague' forced many theatres to close their doors in the early 1590s. Shortly thereafter, in 1593, Shakespeare had his first work, the narrative poem entitled *Venus and Adonis*. The theaters reopened in 1594 and Shakespeare returned to the stage as part of a group called Lord Chamberlain's Men (later the King's Men). He stayed with this group as a dramatist, an actor, and a part owner for many years. In 1599, the company built the Globe, a theater near London. Shakespeare wrote some of his greatest tragic and comedic works around this time. He created *Hamlet*, *Othello*, *King Lear*, and *Macbeth* as well as *Twelfth Night* here. Shakespeare's works were so popular that even Queen Elizabeth I of England had them performed for her.

In his later years, Shakespeare returned home to Stratford-upon-Avon, and died on April 23, 1616. Since his death, there has been some speculation whether he really wrote all of the plays himself or they were written by a group of people. Some have even questioned whether he really existed at all.
